- ii. Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016
- iii. Delhi RPwD Rules, 2018
- iv. The Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007
- v. Delhi Grants to Social welfare Institution/Organization Rules 1975, as amended in 1982.

2. Mission /Visions:

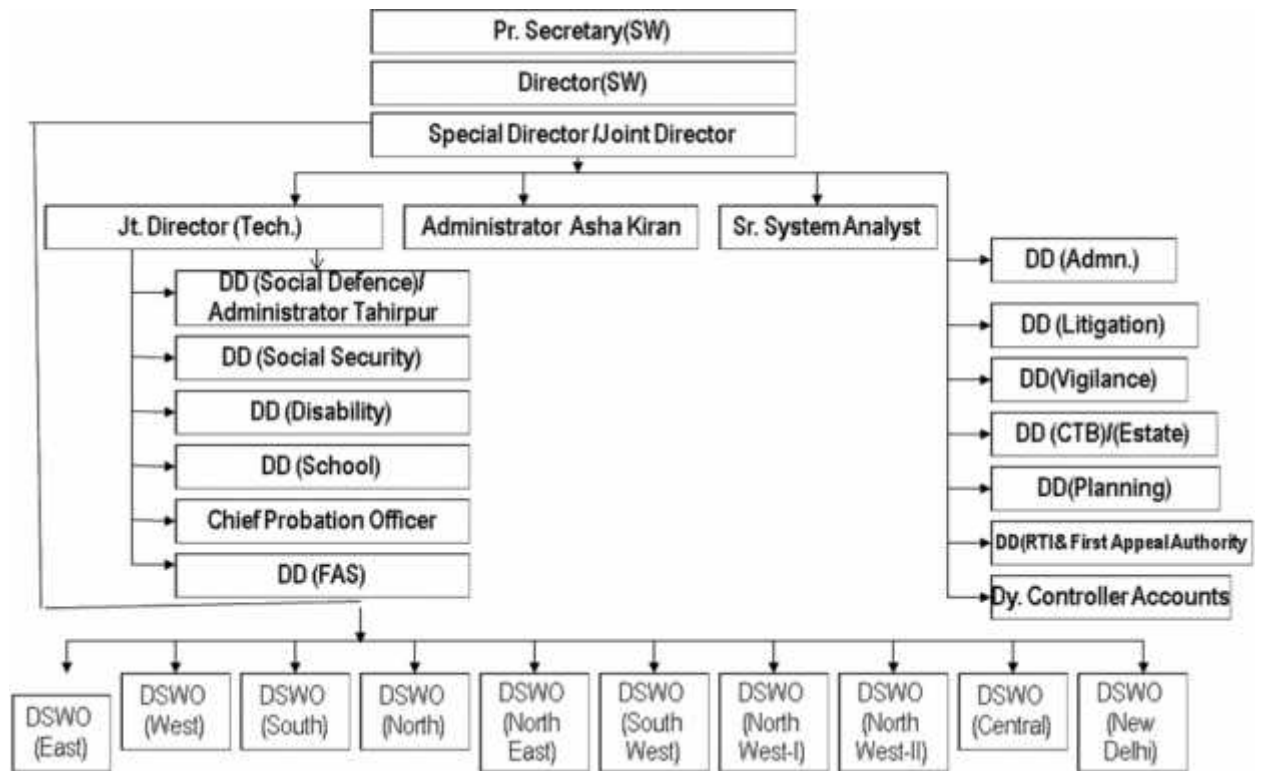
The mission/vision of the social welfare department is Ensuring:

- i. Is to ensure Care , protection and rehabilitation of the neglected, destitute Persons
- ii. Eradication of beggary
- iii. Social Security for the needy senior citizens
- iv. Social Security for disabled persons

3. Brief history and background for its establishment

After independence, the Education Department was providing welfare services which were confined only to four Institutions namely- Children Home, After Care Home for Boys, After Care Home for Women and Lady Noyce School for the Deaf. To organise welfare services in a planned and co-ordinated manner, a separate Department of Social Welfare was setup in the year 1959.

6. Duties to be performed to achieve the mission

To achieve the mission the department has to effectively manage the institutional and non-institutional programmes, which include statutory as well as non- statutory functions. Planning the schemes to achieve physical and financial targets and timely completion of commitments.

 - One School for Blind Boys -155 students,45 (Staff)
 - Five Schools for Hearing Impaired-1385 students, 109 (Staff)
 - One School for Mentally Challenged-69 students, 8 (Staff)
 - 3 Old Age Homes-81 residents, 39 (Staff)
 - 1 Beggar Homes-205 residents,37 (Staff)

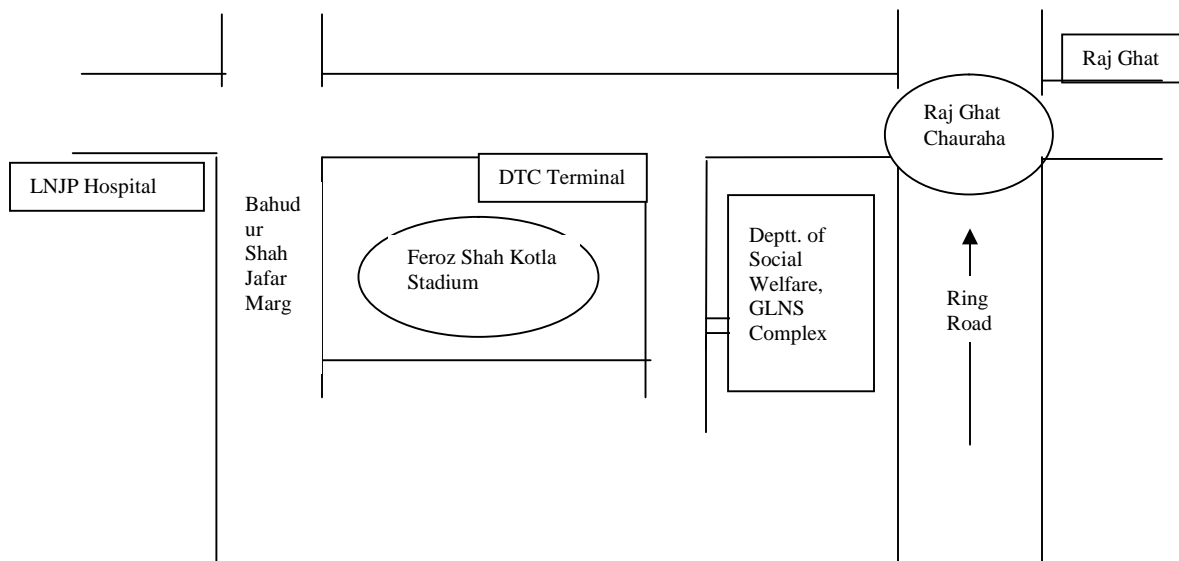
