The Department of Social Welfare, GNCT of Delhi has issued directions from time to time to concerned Department to make Delhi State accessible for Persons with Disabilities. The very good examples of accessibility are Delhi Metro, Low Floor Buses including construction of ramps from road level to footpath. There are 3781 low floor CNG buses available with Delhi Transport Corporation which are accessible to persons with disabilities. There are 412 Cluster Buses running at various routes in Delhi. Some of these buses are also disabled friendly.
